Vineyard

- Age of vines: 50-60 years old vines
- Vineyard: Iván-völgy, south facing slopes
- Training system: bush vines
- Grape variety: Kadarka
- Soil: loess with calcareous 'dolls'
- Yield: 1-1,5 kg
- Winemaker: Csaba Sebestyén

Harvest

- Harvest: September 2012

Winemaking

- Hand picked grapes were selected
- Fermented in open tank
- Aged for 20 months in 6 hl 14-16 years old oak barrels

- Bottled: August 2014
- Number of bottles: 2400
- Residual sugar: 1,3 g/l
- Extract: 26 g/l
- Alcohol: 12,7 %
- Acidity: 5,4 g/l

Kadarka grapes were hand harvested from the steep slopes of the Ivan valley, where our 60-80 years old bush vines are treated with special care. The nose offers a beautiful complexity with hints of spices and red fruits. Mid weight palate of sweet cherries and dried spices along with gentle tannins and fresh acidity. It has silky texture with well integrated oak that leads to a long aftertaste.



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
