## Kadarka

Szekszárd / 2016



### Vineyard

- Age of vines: 10-60 years
- Vineyard: Alsónána, Iván-völgy, Bencze-völgy
- Training system: cordon, bush
- Grape variety: Kadarka
- Soil: loess with calcareous 'dolls'
- Yield: 1-2 kg
- Winemaker: Csaba Sebestyén

### Harvest

- Harvest: September 2016

### Winemaking

- Hand picked grapes were selected
- Fermented in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks between 14-16 C
- 8 months 75% in stainless steel tanks and 25% 5-600 l oak barrels
  
- Bottled: July 2017
- Number of bottles: 4 500
- Residual sugar: 0,9 g/l
- Extract: 24,8 g/l
- Alcohol: 12,0 %
- Acidity: 5,8 g/l

The most ancient variety of the Szekszárd region. Grapes are harvested partly from old vines giving elegance and minerality as well as from younger vines for freshness. It is full of violet and raspberries, with gentle tannins. It begs to be drunk.



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
