Vineyard

- Age of vines: 5-40 years
- Vineyard: Görögszó, Iván-valley, Porkoláb-valley, Szentgál
- Training system: cordon, guyot
- Grape variety: 38% Merlot, 25% Kékfrankos, 23% Cabernet Franc, 7% Sagrantino, 7% Cabernet Sauvignon
- Soil: loess with red clay
- Yield: 1-1,5 kg/vine
- Winemaker: Csaba Sebestyén

Harvest

- Harvest: October 2017

Winemaking

- Hand picked grapes were selected
- Fermented in open tanks between 27-29 C, then macerated for 7 days,
- Aged for 24 months in new and used (Hungarian, French) oak barrels (500 l)

- Bottled: November 2019
- Number of bottles: 1780
- Residual sugar: 1,6 g/l
- Extract: 31,6 g/l
- Alcohol: 14,2 %
- Acidity: 5,1 g/l

Very intense dark berries, with lots of eastern sweet spices and fresh flowers. Full-bodied, dense and chewy with lots of fruits, ripe yet firm tannins and a flavorful finish. Powerful and balanced.
