Vineyard

- Age of vines: 12-14 years
- Vineyard: Iván-valley, Porkoláb-valley, Szentgál
- Training system: cordon, guyot
- Grape variety: 55% Kékfrankos, 26% Cabernet Franc, 19% Merlot
- Soil: loess with red clay
- Yield: 1,5 kg/vine
- Winemaker: Csaba Sebestyén

Harvest

- Harvest: August-September 2024

Winemaking

- Hand picked grapes were selected
- Controlled fermentation in stainless steel tanks at 18 °C for 8 days, 5 months on fine lees
- Bottled: March 2025
- Number of bottles: 5000
- Residual sugar: 1 g/l
- Extract: 20,2 g/l
- Alcohol: 13,5 %
- Acidity: 4,9 g/l

Few years ago we started our journey to perfect our approach to a Provence-style rosé, with an emphasis on the precise expression of details. Refined yet lively, with fresh floral aromas and peach notes. Not overly forceful, but rather discreetly inviting.
