Szekszárd / 2018



### Vineyard

- Age of vines: 3-15 years
- Vineyard: Iván-valley, Porkoláb-valley, Görögszó, Szentgál, Baranya-valley
- Training system: cordon, guyot, bush
- Grape variety: Kékfrankos 50%, Cabernet 21%, Merlot 21%, Kadarka 8%
- Soil: loess with calcareous 'dolls'
- Yield: 1,5 kg
- Winemaker: Csaba Sebestyén

### Harvest

- Harvest: September-October 2018

### Winemaking

- Hand picked grapes were selected
- Fermented in open tanks between 28-30 °C, then macerated for 7 days
- Aged for 22 months in new and used 5 hl oak barrels
  
- Bottled: February 2021
- Number of bottles: 8000
- Residual sugar: 1,5 g/l
- Extract: 29 g/l
- Alcohol: 13,5%
- Acidity: 5,1 g/l

is wine showcases its versatile grape varieties with a good concentration in the mid-palate. Playful but serious at the same time, with all the characteristics of Szekszard region's terroir. Modern expression of Bikaver!
