Vineyard

- Age of vines: 10-60 years
- Vineyard: Iván-valley, Szentgál, Bence-valley
- Training system: cordon, bush
- Grape variety: Kadarka
- Soil: loess with calcareous 'dolls'
- Yield: 1-1,5 kg
- Winemaker: Csaba Sebestyén

Harvest

- Harvest: September 2019

Winemaking

- Hand picked grapes were selected
- Fermented in open tank between 28-30 C
- 10 months 100% in stainless steel tanks

- Bottled: Februar 2021
- Number of bottles: 11 500
- Residual sugar: 0,6 g/l
- Extract: 25,2 g/l
- Alcohol: 12 %
- Acidity: 5,8 g/l

The most ancient variety of the Szekszárd region. Grapes are harvested partly from old vines giving depth and flavours as well as from younger vines for refreshment. It is very light, with gentle tannins. It begs to be drunk.
